The project involves hauling coarse tailings to the ROM and constructing a tailings dam for Rio Tinto Argyle Diamonds at its mine at Argyle in the Kimberley Region of Western Australia.

Macmahon's Indigenous-based contracting subsidiary, Doorn-Djil Yoordaning, took over the Argyle Tailings project from Macmahon in July 2009, and averages a 70% Indigenous workforce.
